The expansion of the Athletic Complex for Flagler College is a Design/Build effort by C. Young Construction, Inc. and VRL Architects, Inc.

The Master Plan has been developed to improve the existing Athletic Complex as Flagler College becomes an NCAA Division II School. The site will include men's baseball, women's softball, soccer and fieldhouse accommodations for both varsity and intramural men and women, as well as visiting teams. The long range plan includes additional public toilets, new concession and maintenance storage facilities. Site development provides new entrance drives, parking and a landscaped setting fitting the image of Flagler College.

The building design motif respects and identifies with the design heritage of the main campus while providing simple economy and function.

The facilities are designed as a small community group which can be developed one structure at a time as funds are available.
