The Design Team was challenged to expand the existing facility within a very tight budget, which included some renovation of the existing library. Construction occurred mostly while the library was in continued operation with a limited amount of closure of this public facility.

The new expansion was conceived to allow the main portion of the library to close while still permitting public access to conference and meeting rooms for after-hours use.

By utilizing metal wall panels, for example, which matched the existing roof, the architects were able to utilize some green building applications although not a project criterion.

The project was completed on schedule with less than one percent in cost modifications
