The newer North Campus was the site for the new 32,650 SF Public Service Building No. 7 with its Fire Science and Law Enforcement Training Center. Building No. 7 includes “live” fire demo labs, flexible classroom space, teaching workout rooms, locker and shower facilities (accommodates both sexes with adjustable partitions for M/F student ratio fluctuations), and emergency vehicle bay storage/demonstration.

This facility also includes a 25 acre Emergency Vehicle Driving Course with a one acre skid pad, chicane, and 1,000 linear feet straightaway. Law Enforcement officers and trainees from all parts of Florida visit and utilize this Driving Course.

New construction on the Main Campus consisted of a new Metal and Woodworking Shop, Building “G”, and a new General Classroom Building “H”. Expansion occurred in the Multipurpose/Cafeteria Building “C”, an addition to the Child Development wing, a new Teaching/Demonstration Kitchen and a renovated Administration Building “A”.

All the work on this project was completed without the loss of a single class day.

Low maintenance block and sloped standing seam metal roofing was utilized on most buildings.
